



FURTHER INFORMATION - Waking Night Support Worker

Training:

The post for which you are applying will lead to a professional qualification in Health and Social Care if you do not already hold one.

If successful, you will complete the Certificate in Care that will provide you with the skills and knowledge to carry out this role. Upon meeting funding eligibility criteria, you will then be supported to complete the Level 2 Adult Care Worker in Health and Social Care qualification. This is by part time study, supported throughout by colleagues, managers and tutors.

Supervision:

You will receive regular reviews of your performance and development throughout the 6-month probationary period and will then have regular supervision meetings with your line manager to support you in your role.

Shifts:

Our standard contracts are 35 hours per week based on five 7 hour shifts.

Smoking:

Please note that we operate a smoke-free environment. Smoking is not permitted in and around all of our premises.

Interview:

If you are invited to interview, please let us know in advance if we can assist with any special needs for the interview process.

Please note: To be suitable for one of our positions you must be eligible to live and work in the UK.
