



FURTHER INFORMATION - Senior Support Worker

Training:

The post for which you are applying will lead to a professional qualification in Health and Social Care if you do not already hold one.

You will have experience in a similar role in a Social Care setting and will either hold or complete the Certificate in Care to ensure your skills are up to date in line with current practice.

You will either hold or be working towards the Level 2 Adult Care Worker in Health and Social Care qualification. This is by part time study, supported throughout by colleagues, managers and tutors.

Supervision:

You will receive regular reviews of your performance and development throughout the 6-month probationary period and will then have regular supervision meetings with your line manager to support you in your role.

Shifts:

Our standard contracts are 35 hours per week based on five 7 hour shifts. Your actual working pattern will be based upon the needs of the service and the people we support. The majority of our positions include working evenings, weekends and sleep-ins. Part time hours are by arrangement. You may be required to work extra hours, which you will be paid for, to enable the people we support to attend appointments at the GP, hospital, etc.

Smoking:

Please note that we operate a smoke-free environment. Smoking is not permitted in and around all of our premises.

Interview:

If you are invited to interview, please let us know in advance if we can assist with any special needs for the interview process.
